Do it Again! is ideal as a bedtime story read aloud, and also appropriate for elementary age children to read to themselves. The writing is engaging and not over simplified. It would give a young reader something to sink her teeth into, without being too long or overwhelming.

There is enough repetition to give the story solid symmetry, but is never so repetitious as to become dull. There actually is real story here. It is not just a simple book that repeats a single sentence with little variation, as do so many books intended for young children. The repetition that is there is an asset, and makes it very cute!
